
BY-LAWS

Article I **NAME:** This is a not for profit organization and shall be known as the:

CITRUS NEWCOMERS CLUB.

Article II **OBJECT:** The purpose of this organization is to encourage appreciation of and familiarization with Citrus County and to provide a means for newcomers to Citrus County to get together to socialize and meet other newcomers.

Article III **MEMBERS:** Membership is open to women who:

- A. are residents of Citrus County;
- B. are interested in the history, culture and appreciation of Citrus County;
- C. want to meet new friends, enjoy programs and visit places of local interest around the county and surrounding areas.

Admission shall be by application and shall include the dues for the fiscal year, which are set by the Executive Board.

Article IV **OFFICERS OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD:** The Officers shall be:

- President
- First Vice President
- Vice President, Programs
- Assistant Programs
- Vice President, Luncheons
- Assistant Luncheons
- Vice President, Membership

- Assistant Membership
- Vice President, Activities
- Assistant Activities
- Recording Secretary
- Assistant Recording Secretary
- Corresponding Secretary
- Assistant Corresponding Secretary
- Treasurer
- Assistant Treasurer
- Parliamentarian

The officers of the Executive Board shall be selected annually by membership vote.

Article V **VOTING:** Officers of the Executive Board shall be elected at the annual general membership

meeting of the CITRUS NEWCOMERS CLUB in April. Each member in good standing shall be allowed one vote.

Article VI **EXECUTIVE BOARD:** The duties of the Executive Board shall be the supervision of all committees, confirmation of directors and committee chairpersons named by the President, and naming a nominating committee of five members, at least three months before the annual election of officers. The nominating committee will prepare a slate of officers for election and conduct the voting process. Nominations may also be made from the floor provided consent has been obtained from the nominee. Directors shall be the governing body of the organization and shall have the sole authority to enter into contracts and execute documents on behalf of the organization. No officer or director may authorize expenditures without the approval of the Executive Board.

Article VII **AMENDMENTS:** These By-Laws may be amended at any regular meeting of this organization by a two-thirds vote of those present if a quorum is declared, or by a majority vote if the amendment has been read at a previous meeting.

Article VIII **CONDUCT OF MEETING:** *Robert's Rules of Order*, as revised, when not in conflict with these By-Laws, shall govern the conduct of meetings of the organization.
